Who We Are: The Professional Trailbuilders Association (PTBA) is non-profit trade association serving professional trail contractors, designers, and consultants. Conference Format: Sessions will be a combination of keynote speakers, 30-40 concurrent sessions (4 per time block), and an outdoor demonstration area. The Association also holds its annual member meetings at the beginning of the conference (2 days).

Attendees: The annual conference brings together 225-325 attendees including PTBA members, trail professionals, land managers, trail advocates, and non-profit organizations.

2019 Location: Two Rivers Convention Center will be the site for the conference, right in downtown Grand Junction. Grand Junction, CO, is a great venue with lots of opportunity for field trips and excursions! During your visit, you will find awe-inspiring natural beauty and the dramatic red rock landscape of the Colorado National Monument and exhilarating outdoor adventures including hiking, camping or skiing on the Grand Mesa. Hundreds of miles of world-class mountain biking trails such as the Kokopelli Trail.
